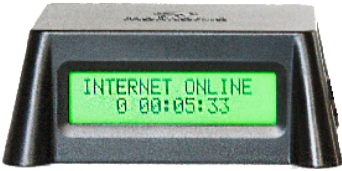

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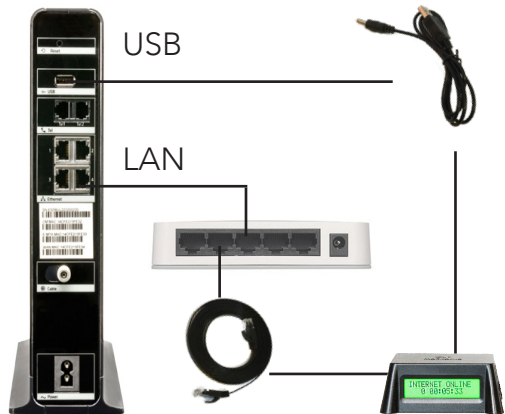
QUICK INSTALL GUIDE



1. Plug one end of the Ethernet cable into the Ethernet port on the I/O Monitor and the other end into a LAN port on your router. If you have multiple routers at your home, we recommend you connect the I/O Monitor to the router closest to the ISP access point.
2. Connect the I/O Monitor's USB power cord to a USB port on the router (for power ONLY). Alternatively, a standalone USB Type A power adaptor could be used. We recommend ones that are rated 2Amps or higher.
3. Wait for the I/O Monitor to complete its boot sequence, until the LCD display shows "INTERNET ONLINE". This may take up to 2 minutes.
4. The LCD display will show the I/O Monitor's ID. You will need this ID to register. The ID is an alphanumeric string formatted like XX-XXXX-XXXX. You may want to write it down or take a picture.

Register Your I/O Monitor

1. Go to my.monitor-io.com to create an account if you have not done so already.
2. Log in to your account and register your I/O Monitor. Go to Account → Register New I/O Monitor
3. After you register, you can review Help → Getting Started for additional information.
